It is an enormous privilege to assist a new believer in understanding the changes that have taken place in their life as a result of salvation. The following study will help you in your preparation.

 **READ: 1 Corinthians 6:19-20; Ephesians 1:13-14**


In the Old Testament, prior to Jesus' life, death, and resurrection, King Solomon built a temple for God. Upon completion, God's presence filled the temple. In the New Testament, after Jesus' return to heaven, God provided every believer with the indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit. This is why a believer's body is referred to as the "temple of the Holy Spirit."


 **WRITE:** When are believers sealed with the Holy Spirit?

 **John 14:15-17; Romans 15:13; Galatians 5:22-23**


 How would you express to a new believer the personal benefits of the Holy Spirit?

 **1 John 4:13-16**

 What are some phrases from these verses that we could use as assurance of salvation and confidence in our relationship with Christ Jesus?


 How would you explain to a new believer the importance of trusting in the truth of Jesus concerning their salvation when they experience temptations to doubt? (Be specific.)


 **Romans 15:15-16**

 How would you explain to others the essential role the indwelling Holy Spirit has in the sanctification process?

 **Philippians 2:12-13**

 What is a new believer's role in the sanctification process?

 What words and phrases would you use to encourage a new believer to be personally disciplined?
