

Helpful Discipleship Reminders:

- Be flexible and obedience to the Lord in determining topics and length of study.
- Commit Your Work to God through Prayer
- Ask Him to prepare and equip you in every way to be sensitive and obedient to His leading.
- Pray God will create within the heart of those you disciple a teachable spirit and a desire to pursue righteousness.
- Ask the Lord to protect your time together and eliminate any obstacles or distractions that may prevent them from hearing truth and surrendering to it.
- Continually commit your efforts to the Lord and leave the results to Him.
- God wants to do a thorough rather than a partial or incomplete work in the lives of His disciples.
- Goal: Teach individuals to develop thought and behavior patterns based on truth while correcting thoughts and actions that oppose truth.

Ask Questions to Evaluate Successful Understanding of Truth:

- What do you understand this truth to mean?
- What do you think the Bible is saying here?

Ask Questions to Promote Personal Application:

- What difference should knowledge of this truth make in your life?
- What would you consider to be some practical ways to practice this particular Scripture?
