 **READ: Romans 6:3-4**

 **WRITE:** Using simple terms, how would you explain what baptism represents or symbolizes?


 **Matthew 28:19-20**


It can be helpful for new believers to recognize that Jesus included baptism in the discipleship process.


 In this passage, why is baptism listed after a person becomes a disciple of Jesus?

 **Acts 8:35-38**

As Philip and a eunuch were traveling along, they came to some water. Because the eunuch believed in Jesus and wanted to publicly identify with Him, he saw nothing standing in the way of him being baptized immediately.

 What are some things that might get in the way or tempt new believers, today, to delay their obedience of baptism?

 How could you encourage believers struggling with the temptations above to follow through in obedience to Jesus? (Be specific.)

 **TO ENCOURAGE:** You are all sons of God through faith in Christ Jesus, for all of you who were baptized into Christ have clothed yourselves with Christ. (**Galatians 3:26-27**)
